

TRONITEC SERVICE DOCUMENT (TSD#2)**WARNING!**

Replacing a TM-U950 printer in the Ruby SuperSystem, without removing the power to the entire system, may cause the system power supply to shutdown, and can cause damage to the system power supply (Power Brick). To remove the power from the entire Ruby system, remove the AC power from the Power Brick. Do not disconnect and reconnect the “W” or “Y” cable to the output of the Power Brick with AC power applied to its input.

After the replacement printer is installed, place the printer’s power switch in the ON position, and then re-apply AC power to the Power Brick. If the TM-U950 needs to be reset, or a printer self-test needs to be performed, use the reset button on the null modem to reset the printer instead of cycling its power.

EXCEPTION: If the TM-U950 is powered by its own PS180 power supply, the printer can be turned on and off without powering down the entire Ruby SuperSystem.
