

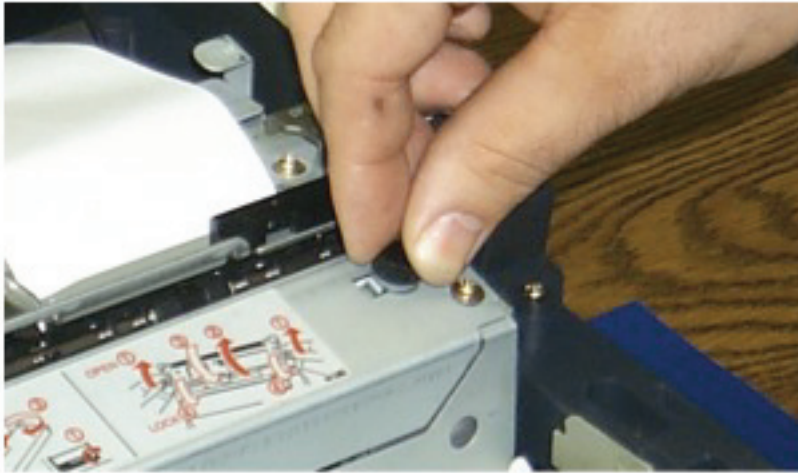
- Power Down the TM-U950 printer prior to opening the printer cover, changing paper or performing maintenance.



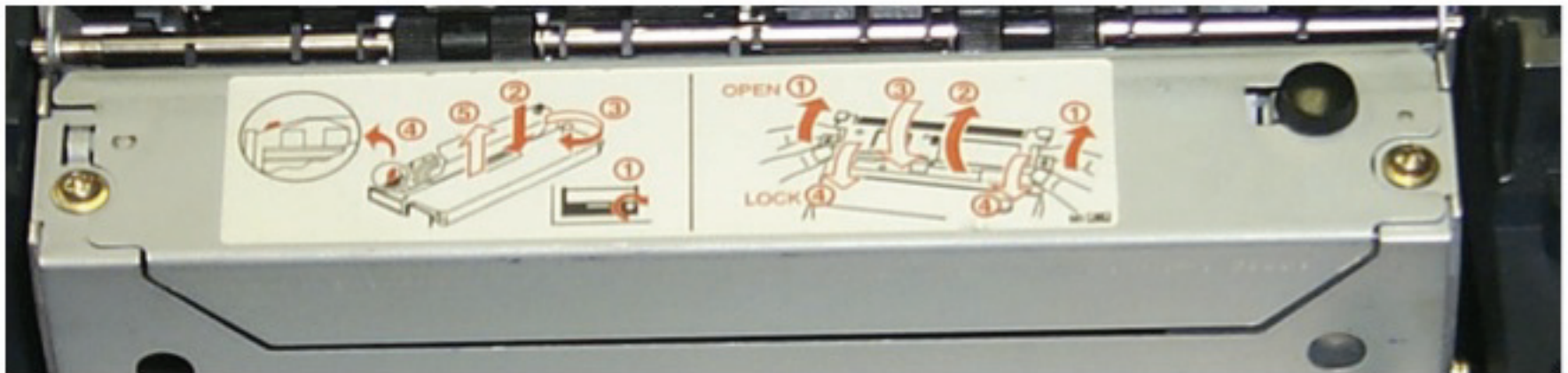
- Carefully remove the printer ribbon before changing paper or repairing a paper jam.



- When installing a new paper roll, always cut approximately 1 foot of paper from the leading edge of the paper.



- Loosen the set screw and carefully remove the coin cover when cleaning the printer or repairing a paper jam.





- Gently slide the print head to the side furthest from the paper printing path with a paper jam.

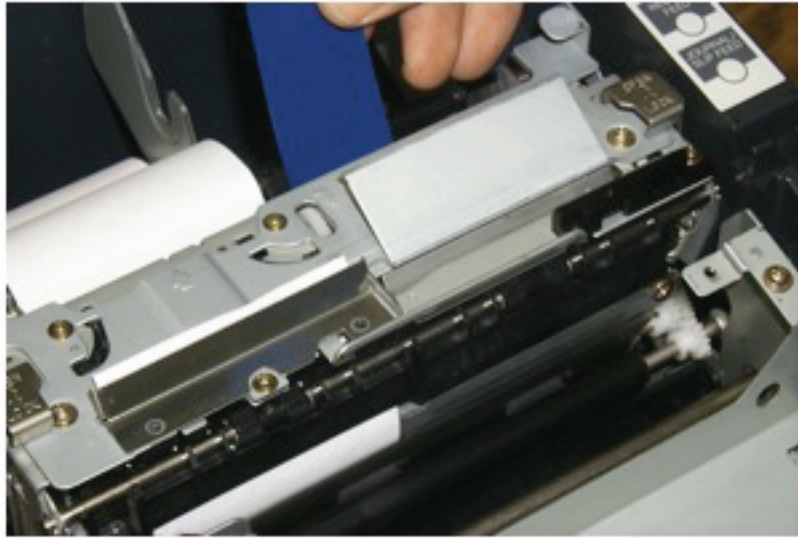


- Gently insert the handy paper jam remover to clear a paper jam.

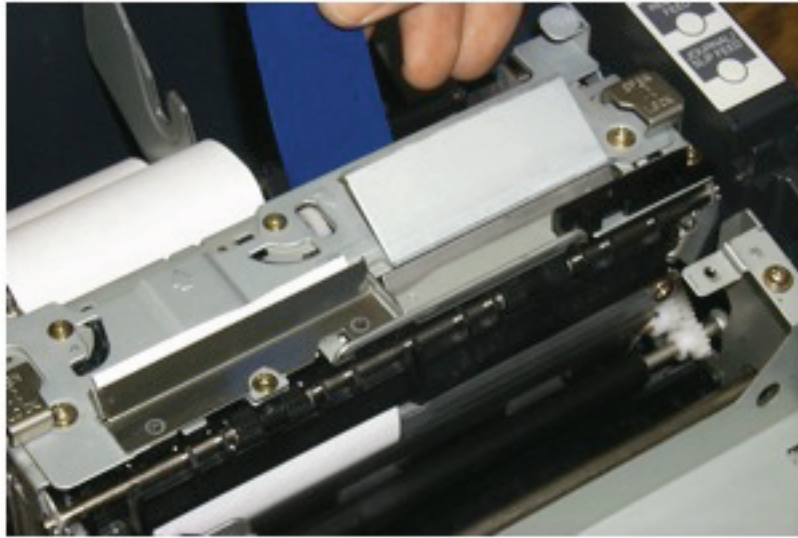


- Gently slide your handy paper jam remover through the paper route. Be careful not to force the handy paper jam remover as it will damage the delicate paper press plate.

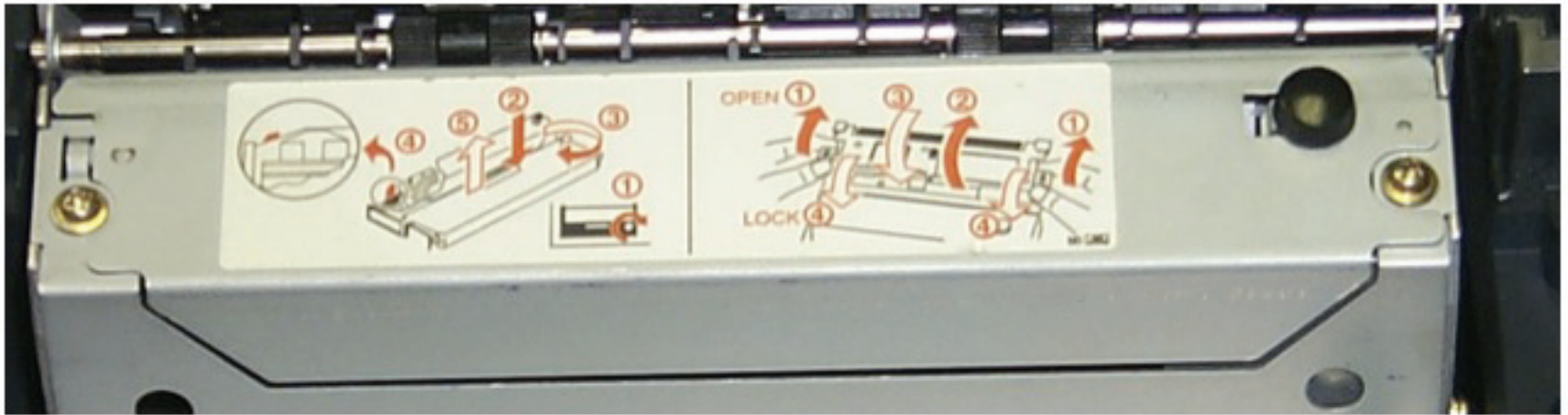

- Grab loose pieces of stray paper with a set of plastic tweezers. Use a can of compressed air to blow dust and debris away from the printing route.

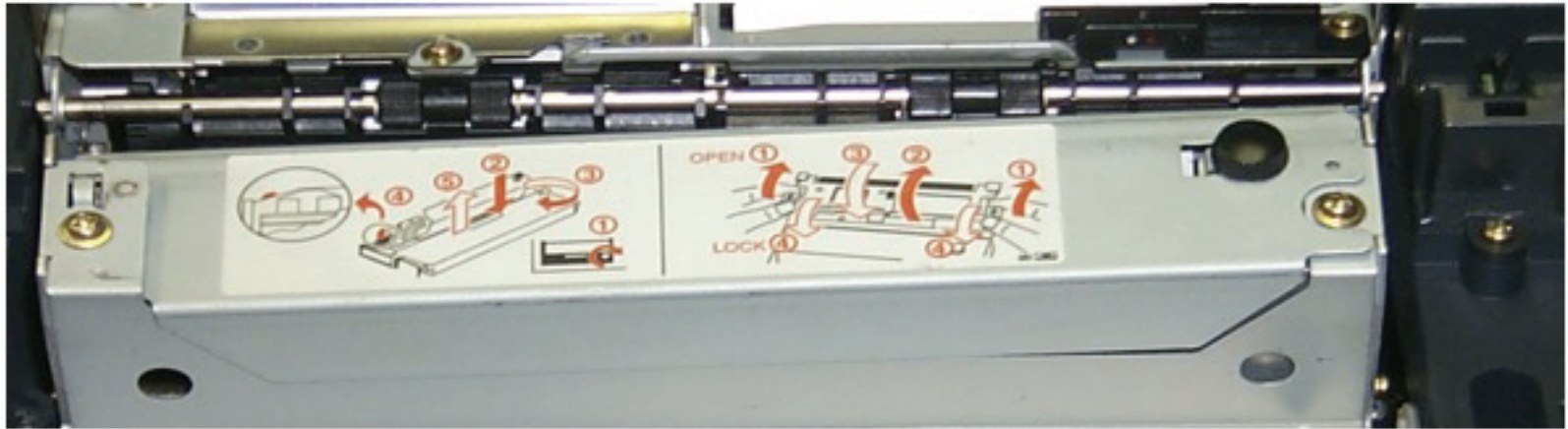
